



## Jon Victor Daniel

October 29, 1936 - July 3, 2022

Jon Victor Daniel, 85, of Lee County, died Sunday, July 3, 2022 at his home.

His funeral service will be at 11 AM on Thursday, July 7, 2022 at the graveside in Cedar Hill Cemetery, Dawson, GA. His family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Wednesday from 5:30-7:00 PM.

Mr. Daniel was born in Sylvester, GA and graduated from Sylvester High School in 1954. He went to ABAC then to the University of Georgia and graduated with a degree in mechanical engineering in 1958. Following his graduation, he served in the U.S. Army and was discharged into the National Guard. He worked with Massey Ferguson until he began farming with his brother Tom. Mr. Daniel served on the Board of the Bank of Terrell, VP of the soybean commission, and on the Georgia Peanut Commission. He was preceded in death by his parents, Howard Alton Daniel and Gladys Little Daniel; wife, Becky Daniel; brothers, Tom Daniel and Bill Daniel; a sister, Joanne Reynolds.

Mr. Daniel is survived by his children: Cristen Daniel Barnes (Jim), Jon Eager "Jed" Daniel (Amy), Martha Daniel White (Eric); grandchildren: Julia Barnes, Victor Barnes, Palmer Daniel, Sydney Daniel, Eli Daniel, Paul White, Ava White, Andie White, and Loxie White; brothers: Pat Daniel and Britt Daniel; sister: Gayle Fitzpatrick.
