Josephine Hewlett Graham, 74, of Roswell, formerly of Albany and Clayton GA, died Friday, April 14, 2006 at Hospice Atlanta in Atlanta, GA. Born in Millen, GA, on August 27, 1931, she was the daughter of the late Samuel Pressey Hewlett and Pauline Oglesby Hewlett. Orphaned at age two, she was reared in the loving home of her late Aunt and Uncle, Mr. and Mrs. Bill (Mary) Hazel in Allendale, SC. Upon graduation from Allendale High School, she was awarded a Byrnes Academic scholarship to The University of South Carolina. She retired from her Federal Civil Service career at MCLB, Albany in 1991 and relocated to Clayton shortly afterward. She was a charter member of Porterfield United Methodist Church. She was predeceased by her beloved husband of 53 years, Marion Reed Graham in 2004. Additionally, she was predeceased by five sisters, Josephine Walker, Esther Hiers, Trixie Mole, Laura Preacher, Dora Harrison, and one brother, W.V. Hazel, all of South Carolina. Survivors include her son, Allan Graham of Roswell, son and daughter-in-law, Lloyd and Kathy Graham of Leesburg and three grandchildren: John Reed Graham, Thomas Lloyd Graham III and Laura Kathryn Graham, all of Leesburg. Additional survivors include her sister, Helen Ginn of Milledgeville, GA and several nieces and nephews.
