Joyce Chambley Kirk, 88, of Albany, died Monday, February 07, 2022 at her home.

Her funeral service will be at 11 AM on Thursday, February 10, 2022 at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Dr. Butch Knight will officiate.

Mrs. Kirk was born in Tifton, GA, and had lived in Albany since 1958. She was a member of the First Baptist Church of Albany where she was a Sunday School teacher for over 30 years.
