Juanita Burnette, 85, of Albany passed away on Wednesday, January 14, 2009 surrounded by family at home. She was born April 18, 1923 in Greensboro, Alabama, the daughter of Bernice and Knox Coshatt. She married William Bentley Burnette on December 10, 1945 in Albany, Georgia. Mr. Burnette preceded her in death on August 25, 1985. Though she and her family lived many places during Mr. Burnette's service in the Air Force, they chose to return to Albany at the time of Mr. Burnette's retirement, making a home with their family. Of all the jobs that Juanita held, the ones that were closest to her heart were the ones she had working with children. She was a child care provider, pre-school teacher and scout leader. These roles enabled her to touch many lives.
