



## Kate Pendleton Lenhardt Owens Obituary

September 14, 1928 - January 1, 2012

Ms. Kate Pendleton Lenhardt Owens, 83, of Albany, GA, died on January 1, 2012 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital after a short illness.

A native of Atlanta, GA, Ms. Owens had resided in Albany for the past 13 years. She was a fourth generation Atlantan and her great grandfather was Judge John L. Pendleton of Superior Court in Atlanta, GA. Mrs. Owens graduated from Washington Seminary in Atlanta where she was a member of the Phi Pi Sorority. She graduated from Mt. Vernon Junior College in Washington, DC with an A.A. Degree, after which she graduated from the University of Georgia with a B.S. in Education and was a member of the Phi Mu Sorority. Ms. Owens was a member of the Second Ponce DeLeon Baptist Church in Atlanta. She was a former debutante, a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution, and a Sustainer Emeritus of the Junior League of Albany, GA. Ms. Owens was preceded in death by her parents, Mr. and Mrs. J. B. Lenhardt of Atlanta, GA.
