Mr. Kevin James Marks, 50, of Albany died Wednesday, September 16, 2015 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. Kevin was born in Boston, MA on February 6, 1965, and was raised in Massachusetts and Connecticut. He graduated from East Catholic High School, Manchester, CT in 1983 and attended Texas Christian University, graduating in 1987. His television career as a news reporter and an anchor moved him around several stations in Texas – Fort Worth, College Station, and Abilene. Once off camera, Kevin moved into sales at KTEN in Ardmore OK. In 2001, he began his sales career at WALB in Albany, GA. Hardworking and ever the salesman, Kevin won awards year after year for his efforts. He left his Regional Sales Manager position in 2014.

Kevin was predeceased by his mother Phyllis (Kuzma) Marks. He is survived by his father and stepmother, James and Doris Marks of Inverness, FL; his sister Kimberly Murphy and brother-in-law Robert of South Windsor, CT; his niece Colleen Murphy of South Windsor, CT as well as multiple aunts, uncles and cousins.
