



Mr. Larry Butch Human Obituary

December 25, 1944 - September 26, 2013

Larry Dillard (Butch) Human, 68, of Albany, died Thursday September 26, 2013 at Willson Hospice House.

A memorial service will be held Saturday (Today) 2 PM at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors. Rev. Olin Johnson will officiate. The remains have been cremated.

A native of Harriman, TN, Mr. Human had lived in the Albany area since 1973. He was the owner and operator of Ditch Witch of Albany for 39 years. He served in the U. S. Army during the Vietnam war and received the Bronze Star valor service medal. He was preceded in death by his parents, Dillard and Esther Human and brothers, Kendall Cyrus Human and Sam Human.
