Mr. Larry W. Marchbanks, 62, 361 Flowing Well Rd, Leesburg, died July 5, 2008. His memorial service will be Tuesday 2 PM at Kimbrell-Stern with visitation to following the service, Rev. John Edmondson officiating. A native of Phoenix City, AL, Mr. Marchbanks had lived in Albany most of his life. He was employed with Water Gas and Light for 42 years.
