



## Lavon Willard Boyett

Lavon Willard Boyett, 88, died Sunday, July 11 at Magnolia Manor in Americus, GA.

Her funeral service will be at 10 AM on Saturday, July 17, 2021 at the First Baptist Church of Albany, 145 Oakland Parkway with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev.
