



Lawrence J Des Jardines, Sr. Obituary

July 11, 1931 - July 2, 2006

Major Lawrence Joseph Des Jardines, Sr., USMC retired, died Sunday, July 2, 2006 in Albany. A funeral mass will be recited at 10 AM Thursday, July 6, 2006 at St. Teresa's Catholic Church. with Rev. Finbarr Stanton officiating. Interment will be at Crown Hill Cemetery. Born in the Bronx, New York, he had lived in Albany since 1969. He graduated from C.J. Scott High School in East Orange New Jersey and enlisted in the New Jersey National Guard in 1948. In 1950 he enlisted in the United States Marine Corps and was commissioned as an officer in 1953 during combat in Korea. He also served in Vietnam and was awarded the Bronze Star with Combat V. He retired in 1973 with the rank of Major. He received an A.A. degree in Business Management from Albany Junior College and also attended Albany State College. After retirement he worked as the Director of Environmental Services at Palmyra Park Hospital. Maj. Des Jardines was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church, served as Troop Committee Chairman for the Boy Scouts of America, was secretary-treasurer and member of the Albany Chapter of the Retired Officers Association, was Allocations Chairman and member of the Board of Directors for the United Way of Albany and served as an usher and lector at St. Michael's Parish Church at the Marine Corps Supply Center. Survivors include his wife, Mary Greaves Des Jardines, a daughter, Ellen Marion Des Jardines of Athens, two sons, Lawrence Joseph Des Jardines, Jr. of Indianapolis, IN, David Edward Des Jardines and his wife Shelley of Danielsville, GA, eight grandchildren, Erin, Meagan, Jessie, Peggy, Maria, Samantha, Mary and

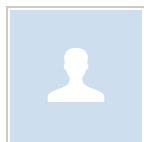
