Mr. Leo Harrison, 76, of Leesburg died Wednesday May 16, 2018 at his residence.

His funeral service will be held Saturday 2:00PM at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. Damon Fountain will be officiating. The family will receive friends Friday from 6:00 to 8:00PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

Born in Kentucky, Mr. Harrison was the owner and operator of the Fireplace and Heater Shop. He was a veteran of the Vietnam War serving in U.S. Army where he was a Military Policeman "(95B)" Criminal Justice N.C.O.I.C. U.S. Army Color Guard Georgia. Mr. Harrison was Life Members of the VFW and American Legion Post #30 & 1. He was Entertainer-Georgia State Fair-center court on stage for 5 years, Entertainer at Albany, GA Nursing Homes 5 years and Entertainer Pelham, GA 15 years on stage with a paralyzed vocal cord. He was also stage entertainer-Georgia National Fairgrounds 5 years. Mr. Harrison was inducted into Georgia Music Hall of Fame in Macon, GA w/Pelham Jamboree Entertainer. He was Chief Indian Marshall "Cherokee Indians of Georgia Inc."

Mr. Harrison was preceded in death by his parents Jesse and Delie Harrison and brother Charlie Harrison.

Survivors include his wife Faye Farmer Harrison of Leesburg; two daughters Sherri Sholar and her husband Jerald of Kingstree, SC; Tana Harrison Mullis and her fiancé Russell Duke of Leesburg; five grandchildren Kayln Faulk,

Kolton Damerow, Kylee Sholar, JD Sholar and Kamri Tatum Duke; two brothers Mack Harrison and lewie J. Harrison; two sisters Kathy Kelly and Shirl Tritsch.
