Mr. Leonard M. Knight, 90, of Albany died Monday June 23, 2014 at Lee County Health Care.

Born in Sylvester, GA, Mr. Knight lived in Albany most of his life where he was a retired. He worked 55 years in the Automobile Industry his entire career as a salesman, sales manager and owner. He was a member of the Exchange Club of Albany for 53 years where he was a Past President, Exchangite of the year and was serving as the Honorary Chaplain of the Exchange Club.
