Mrs. Leonora Spivey "Baby" Arnold, 91 died Thursday, March 28, 2013 at Lee County Health Care.

Born in Eatonton, Mrs. Arnold had lived in Albany since 1951. She had worked at the Albany Chamber of Commerce from 1988 to 1994.
