



Lila Brady Brim Obituary

April 9, 1928 - July 9, 2006

A service in memory of Lila Brady Brim, 78 of Sasser who died Sunday, July 9, 2006, will be conducted at 11 AM Wednesday at the Episcopal Church of the Holy Spirit in Dawson. Her cremated remains will be interred in the family plot at Eastside Cemetery in Statesboro at a later date. A native of Bullock County, she graduated Summa cum laude from Georgia Teachers College, now Georgia Southern University in 1949. She taught at Terrell County High School in Dawson until 1970 when she began her tenure with and originated the library at Terrell Academy, teaching there until her retirement in 1992. Throughout her 38 years of teaching, her love for her student extended beyond the classroom. Not only was she an advisor for Hi-Y, Tri-Hi-Y, annual staff, school newspaper, and numerous literary events; she was also a beloved friend and mentor. In 1951 she married John Henry Brim of Sasser where they continued to live until his death in 1991. She is survived by her daughter, Ann Brim Streat of Sasser and a granddaughter, Elizabeth Ann Streat of Atlanta. The family will receive friends Tuesday, 6 to 8 PM at Kimbrell-Stern.
