Mrs. Lillian Fryer Davis, 85, died at home on Monday, May 3, 2004, after a twenty-eight year battle with cancer. Mrs. Davis was a lifelong volunteer at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital and was their Volunteer of the Year in 2002. Her most recent assignments were at the Women's Center as a Reach to Recovery volunteer and at the Diabetic Care Center. A native of Blakely, Mrs. Davis was the widow of beloved community leader, J.I. Davis, Jr. She attended Shorter College and was a graduate of the University of Georgia where she was a member of Kappa Delta Sorority. Mrs. Davis was a member of the Albany Junior League, the Albany Charity League, and the Palmyra Heights Garden Club, which she had served twice as president. She was a former leader for both Boy Scout and Girl Scout troops. She was a member of First United Methodist Church and the Fellowship Sunday School Class.
