Col. Lloyd G. Wentworth, Jr., 1720 Marbury Lane, died Wednesday at Palmyra Medical Center. His funeral service will be 10 AM Saturday Kimbrell-Stern. Entombment will be at Crown Hill Mausoleum with full military honors. Chaplin Andy Goode and Rev. Roy Cook officiating. Col. Wentworth was retired from the U S Air Force serving in World War II, the Korean Conflict and Vietnam. He was former POW and received a Purple Heart and flew over 200 combat missions in Korea. Col Wentworth was a member of the American Legion Post 40, the VFW, Past Master at Masonic Lodge #708. He was a Worthy Patron twice with the Order Eastern Star #450, Hasan Temple and the Scottish Rite. He was a member of the Southwest Georgia Sportsmen Club, Georgia Defense Force, Air Force Sergeants Association and the Golden Eagles with the NRA. He was preceded in death by his wife Carlene E. Wentworth and a son Lloyd G. Wentworth, III. Survivors include his daughter, Dawn E. Smith, Chattanooga, TN; sons, Raymond Wentworth and his wife Lynn, Jasper, GA, Mahlon Wentworth and his wife Teresa, Albany; and 7 grandchildren. The family will receive friends Friday from 6 to 8 PM at Kimbrell-Stern.
