April 6, 1909 - July 4, 2008

Lois Phelps Peters, 99, of Albany, died Friday July 4, 2008. Mrs. Peters was born April 6, 1909 in Sale City, GA to King David and Molly West Phelps. She graduated from Sale City High School in 1926 and began her teaching career in 1927 at Pine Hill, a three bedroom school in rural Mitchell County in an era when the teacher built the fire and had kerosene available for the student that might step on a nail. She taught in a time when the seventh grade was equivalent to a college degree. There were times early in her career that she taught without pay when the county ran out of money. In 1931, she married Alvin Burbanks Peters. After marrying, she attended Valdosta State College and received a degree in Elementary Education from Georgia Women's College. She taught at Sale City, Cairo, Camilla, Baconton, and Albany. Mrs. Peters retired from teaching in 1973. She loved teaching, and had fond memories of it which she reflected on during her retirement years. She was preceded in death by her husband in June of 1957, and by a daughter in law: Sylvia Peters. She is survived by a daughter and son in law: Gloria and Alton Couch, Albany; a son: Yates W. Peters, Atlanta a sister: Marylou Collins, Camilla grandchildren: Mark Couch, Stan and Karan Couch, Hal and Sandra Peters, Whitney Peters and Dr. Carolyn Amadeo; 7 great grandchildren.
