LORENE HARRIS OWENS, DIED SUNDAY, MAY 28, 2023 AT THE RESIDENCE OF SUSAN AND PHIL GREENE.

FUNERAL SERVICES WILL BE GRAVESIDE ON WEDNESDAY, MAY 31, AT 11:00 AM AT CROWN HILL CEMETERY, 1907 DAWSON ROAD, ALBANY, GA. THE REV. THAD HAYGOOD WILL OFFICIATE.

LORENE WAS BORN OCTOBER 30, 1923 IN OAKFIELD, GA. AFTER GRADUATION FROM COLLEGE, SHE MOVED TO ALBANY AND WORKED FOR YANCEY TRACTOR COMPANY. SHE MARRIED CHARLES INMAN OWENS IN 1944. SHE THEN BECAME A HOMEMAKER AND SEVEN YEARS LATER BECAME A LOVING MOTHER TO THEIR ONLY CHILD, SUSAN.

LORENE WAS A LIFE MEMBER OF THE CHARITY LEAGUE OF ALBANY. SHE CHAIRED MANY COMMITTEES IN THE CHARITY LEAGUE WHILE SHE WAS ACTIVE. SHE WAS ALSO VERY ACTIVE IN THE ACTIVITIES AT DEERFIELD WINDSOR SCHOOL WHEN GRANDMOTHERS WERE NEEDED. AS A WIFE OF A MEMBER OF THE EXCHANGE CLUB, SHE BECAME VERY INVOLVED WITH THE EVENTS AND TRAVELS INVOLVING THE EXCHANGE CLUB. FOR 79 YEARS, SHE WAS A LIFELONG MEMBER

OF FIRST UNITED METHODIST CHURCH OF ALBANY.

LORENE WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HER HUSBAND, CHARLES INMAN OWENS, JR., HER PARENTS AND FIVE SIBLINGS.
