Mrs. Louise Edwards Hall, 82, died peacefully, surrounded by her family, on September 29, 2018 at her home.

The funeral service will be held at 3:00 PM on Tuesday, October 2, 2018 at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow in Crown Hill Cemetery. The family will receive friends on Tuesday from 2:00 PM until the Service Hour at Kimbrell-Stern.

Louise was born in Atlanta, graduated from O'Keefe High School before attending the Atlanta Division of the University of Georgia, now known as George State University. She was employed early on by the Citizens and Southern Bank of Atlanta. It was there that she met her late husband, James C. Hall.

In 1964, the Halls relocated to Albany where her husband headed the Trust Department for Citizens and Southern Bank of Albany. Active in the community, Louise was Past President of the Junior League of Albany, Inc. and Past President of the Albany Charity League.
