Mrs. Louise Mills, 82, of 323 Byron Plantation Road, died Sunday, May 11, 2008, at Palmyra Nursing Home. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 PM Wednesday, May 14, 2008 at St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Albany, GA with interment to follow at Riverside Cemetery. The Very Rev. Mark Jones will officiate. Mrs. Mills was born March 14, 1926 in Paris, TX. After graduating from high school in Waco, TX, she went on to earn a teaching degree from Southwest Texas State Teachers College in San Marcos, TX. While attending college, she supported the World War II effort by painting bombs at the Bluebonnett Ordnance Plant in McGregor, TX. She met Blanton Mills who was stationed at Lackland Air Force Base in San Antonio, TX. They married on November 9, 1946. After moving to Albany, GA in 1952, Mrs. Mills became very active in local civic organizations. She was a member of the Junior League of Albany, the Garden Club of Albany, and the Albany Junior Woman's Club. She was also an active member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, serving on the Altar Guild, and as treasurer of St. Mary's chapter of the church. Mrs. Mills loved cooking, gardening, traveling, and playing bridge. She also had great compassion and love for animals. Survivors include her husband: Blanton Mills, a daughter: Peggy Mills, Albany; a daughter and son-in-law: Debbie and Randy Cothren, Bainbridge, GA; a son and daughter-in-law: Reid and Mary Mills, Albany, GA. She is also survived by a brother and sister-in-law: Dr. James E. Hoban and his wife Dorothy Ellen Hoban of Corpus Christi, TX. Grandchildren include: Rebecca Trainor, Rachael Thompson, Pamela
