Lyle "Mack" Wayne McClung III, 72, passed away on March 19, 2025 in Albany, GA.

He was a dedicated crossword solver, a great fan of the outdoors, and a beloved father, son, brother, and friend.

Mack was born on March 15, 1953 in Albany, GA to parents Lyle "Buddy" Wayne McClung, Jr.

and Carolyn Phillips McClung, and was a lifelong resident of The Good Life City. He grew up

School, and going on to dedicate his life to woodworking and construction.

He worked for LRA Construction for 31 years, eventually working as a superintendent on

industrial, commercial, educational, and government projects across southwest Georgia.

Mack had two children, Jamie and John. He enjoyed fishing with them and going canoeing on

the Muckalee Creek while they were kids. He has passed on his interest in house DIY projects

and handiwork to Jamie and his appreciation for small-town Georgia life to John.

Mack enjoyed old western films, Shakespeare, collecting items from out in nature, and sitting on the Muckalee quietly. Mack was also known as a friend to all at the local watering hole, AJ's, and was always ready to talk about trivia and history. He enjoyed reminiscing about his childhood adventures with various unique pets, baking lemon meringue pies, and road trips to help out friends. Mack spent many hours the past few years doing crossword puzzles and quizzing friends and family with trivia he learned from television. Mack is survived by his two children, Jamie and John; and his siblings Sam McClung of South Carolina, David McClung of Dothan, AL, and Nancy Lawless of Hoschton, GA.
