Mack G. Knight, 79 of Albany died Wednesday, November 2, 2005 at his residence following an illness. The funeral service will be 11 AM, Friday at Byne Memorial Baptist Church with interment to follow in Crown Hill Cemetery. Dr. William H. Sims III and Rev. Greg Aldridge will officiate. Mr. Knight was a native of Lee County. He served his county proudly as a member of the United States Army and was a participant in the Rhineland Central European Campaign, receiving the EAME Service Medal With 2 Bronze Service Stars and a Good Conduct Medal. He retired from WESCO Distribution and was a member of the Exchange Club of Albany. He became a member of Byne Memorial Baptist Church in 1966 and served as Deacon, Youth Leader and gave of his time to many other areas of his church. Survivors include his wife of 53 years, Gwen Reynolds Knight of Albany, 2 daughters: Sharon Culpepper of Orlando FL, and Penny Knight and her husband Gary of Leesburg, a grandson Brian A. Knight of Atlanta, a granddaughter, Suzette Knight of Athens, GA, 2 brothers Thad and Tom Knight of Leesburg and numerous nieces and nephews.
