Madonna “Donna” Myler, 87, of Leesburg, died Thursday, at her son’s residence surrounded by her family.

The Funeral Mass will be held at 2 PM Tuesday at St. Teresa’s Catholic Church with the Rev. Ray Leverault officiating. Inurnment will follow in the columbarium at St. Teresa’s Catholic Church. The family will receive friends Monday from 6 PM until 8 PM at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors.

She was born and grew up in Mitchell, SD where she graduated from Notre Dame Academy. Mrs. Myler attended Albany Junior College. She was employed by the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Washington, DC where she met and married her husband, Jerry Myler, Jr. They moved to Albany and she began working at the American Cancer Society. Mrs. Myler retired as the Executive Director after 30 years of service. She was an active member of St. Teresa’s Catholic church and served as president of The Council of Catholic Women, served on the Parrish Council and was co-chair of the first International Dinner. Mrs. Myler served on various other committees. She was preceded in death by her parents, Mathias and Stella Kirsch and her husband, Jerome Paul Myler, Jr., and a son, Robert Myler and a brother, Dale Kirsch.
