September 18, 1902 - August 17, 2003

Born September 18, 1902 in Barnesville, GA, Mrs. Pinkston has lived in Nashville a number of years. She was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church and of St. Henry's Church in Nashville, TN. Mrs. Pinkston was chosen as Albany's Woman of the Year for 1970. She volunteered many hours of her time with various organizations. She served as a full-time volunteer secretary at the USO, where she held various offices, and represented Albany at national USO meetings. She was past president of the Albany USO. She was deeply involved with Georgia State Crippled Children's Clinic in Albany. Mrs. Pinkston held offices in the Council of Catholic Women, and in the Columbus Deanery. She was past-president of the Alter Society and the Charity League. She volunteered with Civil Defense, was a charter member and past-president of the American Legion Auxiliary and supervisor of the American Red Cross bandage room in World War II. She was past officer of the Albany Garden Club, and charter member and past officer of both the Albany Pilot Club and Easter Seal Guild
