Magid Munir Qaqish, 47, of Albany, died Tuesday, January 28, 2025 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

His funeral mass will be Saturday, 11:00 AM at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with burial to follow in Crown Hill Cemetery. There will be a wake service at 6:00 PM on Friday, January 31, 2025 at Kimbrell-Stern with visitation to follow until 8:00 PM.

Magid was born and raised in Albany. He graduated from Westover High School in 1995. He attended Albany Junior College after high school. He then graduated from Valdosta State in 2000 with a Bachelor's Degree in Exercise Science.

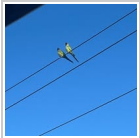
