Troy was born in Wilcox County Georgia and later moved with his family to Savannah, GA, a city he always said "makes me smile with my heart." There he became an Eagle Scout and was part of a gospel quartet, The Rhythmairs. Music continued to be his passion throughout his life. Troy was a popular disc jockey in the West Point area, hosting events and calling football games for many years. He also served in the Navy Reserve. Moving to Albany in 1963, he was a sales representative until he grew tired of traveling and being away from his family. He was employed by the City of Albany Communications Dept. until retirement. Troy was a dedicated and loyal Golden K Kiwanian serving as president as well as Lt. Governor for Division 3. He was the recipient of many Kiwanis awards and honors including the Georgia Outstanding Leader Award, the Lamar Stewart Memorial Award and the coveted George Hixon Fellowship Award. He was a communicant at St. Patrick's Episcopal Church, was an expert fisherman and derived much pleasure from the outdoors and being on the water. He also learned late in life how pets brought companionship and love and cared very deeply for his two cats and two dogs. Troy will be greatly missed by his family and friends. Mr Fore was preceded in death by his parents, James and Carrie Fore, two step children, Gwen Freeman Drury and Dru Freeman, two sisters and two brothers. Survivors include his wife, Patricia Fore of Albany, two sons, Jamie Fore (Renaë) of Gloucester, VA and Troy Fore of Albany, a daughter, Lisa Fore Sheffield (Scott) of Brevard, NC, son in law, John Meadors of Albany,

one sister, Joyce Fore of Slidell, LA and 4 grandchildren.
