Malcolm E. Pierce died on November 2, 2015 in Minneapolis, MN, age 90. A memorial service will be held in Minneapolis, MN on November 10, 2015. Graveside services will be held Friday, November 13, 2015 at 11:00AM at Parrott City Cemetery in Parrott, GA. Visitation will be held Friday, November 13, 2015 from 9:45AM until 10:15 AM at Kimbrell-Stern.
