



## Mansfield R. Cole Obituary

June 25, 1914 - October 7, 2006

A native of Worth County GA, Mr. Cole was a retired civil service employee and a resident of Albany since 1944. He was a member of Raleigh White Baptist Church. He was also a member of Masonic Lodge #591, the Hasan Shrine Temple and the Albany Shrine Club, where he was on the Director's Staff and the Royal Order of Jesters. He was a 32nd degree KCCH Scottish Rite Mason and Yorkshire Mason, of which he was sponsor of the Knight's Templar Eye Foundation. His memberships also included The Elk's and Moose Clubs plus the Good Sam Camping Club and the AARP. Mr. Cole was preceded in death by his wife, Elise Gaines Cole, and sisters: Mary Cole Jones, Estelle Cole Johnson, Verna Mae Cole Shealy, and Alice Cole Fussell; Brothers: J.C., Bryant, Jessie and Jack Cole.
