Margaret Lenderman Bridges, 88, of Albany, GA, died Wednesday, December 20, 2023.

Her funeral service will be at 2 PM on Saturday, December 23, 2023 at Gillionville Baptist Church. Flynn Bridges and the Rev. Keith Alderman will officiate. The family will receive friends at Gillionville Baptist Church prior to the funeral service beginning at 1 PM. The burial service will be private for family only at Crown Hill Cemetery.

Margaret was born in Jefferson, GA, on November 10, 1935. She attended school in Gainesville, GA, Mercer University, and Bauder Finishing School. While at Mercer University, she met William Hautman Bridges and they married on December 28, 1954. During their marriage they lived in Augusta, Dawson, Atlanta, Savannah, Midwest City, Oklahoma, and finally in Albany since 1970.

She was a past member of the Auxiliary to Dougherty County Medical Society and the Suburban Women's Club. She was an active participant of Phoebe's Golden Key Walking track for many years.

Margaret was a member of Gillionville Baptist Church and the Women of Faith Sunday School class.

She was preceded in death by her husband William Hautman Bridges, MD, her parents Ellis Luther Lenderman and Velna Garrison Baker, her sister, Elizabeth Orvin and her brother Harold Lenderman.
