Margaret Jo Hogg passed peacefully on October 17, 2022, at the Oaks in Leesburg, Georgia. A graveside service will be held at 1:30 PM on Friday, October 21, 2022 at the graveside at Westview Cemetery, 168 Westview Dr., SW, Atlanta, GA 30310.

Margaret Jo was preceded in death by her parents, Mr. Joseph W. Hogg and Mrs. Ethel Lloyd Hogg, and her brother, John William Hogg.

Margaret Jo was an educator in the Dougherty County School System for 33 years. She was an avid Albany High School Indian Fan. She was sponsor of many clubs and organizations during her teaching career. She was loved by all her students and co-workers. She continued to volunteer for the Dougherty County Athletic Association for years after her retirement.

Margaret Jo was a volunteer at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital for 25 plus years. She was on the board of the Dougherty County Public Library for many years.

Margaret Jo was diagnosed with Alzheimer's at the age of 69 and attended the Alzheimer's Center at First Methodist Church. In 2020, the Margaret Jo Hogg Alzheimer's Outreach Center was built in honor of her.

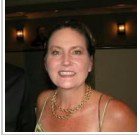

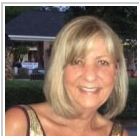
