She was born on February 5, 1921, the daughter of Lena Bell Haddock Moss and George Dallas Moss in Albany, Georgia. She had one sister, Dorothy Moss Carter. She graduated from Albany High School in the Class of 1938. She lived in her much-loved hometown of Albany for the majority of her life, moving to Pensacola in 1998. Margaret married John (Buck) Hines Stovall in 1938 who was killed in action while serving in the U.S. Navy during World War II. She married Garrett (Sonny) Andrew Fleming, Jr. in 1946 who preceded her in death in 1971. Her long-time friend and companion, Charles V. Tyson, died in 1995. Margaret had a 21-year career as the Lunch Room Manager at Magnolia Elementary School in Albany. Margaret was an inspiration to her children and those who knew her. She was most generous to family, friends and colleagues and cared for her own Mother, Lena Stewart, until her death at age 100. With a passion for cooking and baking, she always ensured that holidays and birthdays were special celebrations. She had a grand sense of humor. She was a proud member of the First United Methodist Church of Albany for 81 years, having joined at age nine in 1930. She continued her membership after her move to Florida and still took great pleasure in reading the Church's monthly bulletin. She enjoyed her many friendships in Pensacola as well as her longtime friendship with Mrs. Helen Loyless of Albany with whom she had been a close friend for 81 years.
