Mrs. Marguerite Green Kinney, 95, died Friday, December 19, 2014 at Lee County Health and Rehabilitation. Visitation will be held at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Home from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM on Sunday, December 21. The funeral service will be held on Monday December 22 at 11:00 am in the Ministry Center of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church.

Mrs. Kinney was born in rural Lee County, Georgia on June 1, 1919, to the late Ned Walker and Ruby Harris Green. She was a graduate of Albany High School, class of 1937. She married the late J. Lloyd Kinney in 1939 and the two of them enjoyed over 58 years of marriage.

Mrs. Kinney was a member of the Albany Area Artist Guild and was an accomplished artist winning numerous awards for her paintings. Her art reflected her appreciation of the beauty she saw in her native Southwest Georgia and during the many travels she and Lloyd enjoyed throughout the United States.

She and Lloyd shared a deep appreciation of God's creation which was reflected in their hobbies. Marguerite had a "green thumb" and the flowers in her garden ranged from orchids to day lilies, many of which became the subjects of her paintings. Together they were active members of the Audubon Society, Albany Rock and Mineral Club, Kolomoki Society, Retired Railroad

Club, and Sowega Good Sam Club. Marguerite was a member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church.

Marguerite was the eldest of six siblings and had a deep love for family. She survived by her sister, Nell Thomas (David) and numerous nieces and nephews whom she loved dearly. She is also survived by her children, Tommy Kinney (Helen), Konnya Kinney Bell (Andy), Dr. Davis Kinney (Angel), her grandchildren Brian Kinney, Zachary Bell, Nathan Bell, Mary Catherine Kinney, Reese Kinney, and Jake Kinney, and her great grandchildren Skyler and Frankie Kinney.
