Marie Derry DeLamar, 93, of Albany, died Saturday, September 10, 2016.

Mrs. DeLamar's remains were cremated. Information about memorial services will come at a later date.

Mrs. DeLamar was born in Atlanta. She graduated from Albany High School with the Class of 1939. She graduated from North Georgia College in 1942. Following college, she lived in Macon, GA and married Leonard Gibson DeLamar, Sr. in 1946. The family moved several times, following the career and assignments of Mr. DeLamar, who was in the U.S. Air Force Reserves, serving as a flight instructor training pilots for the U. S. Air Force. The family permanently returned to Albany in 1961. Mrs. DeLamar was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church. She was an active member of the DAR, and held various offices in both the State and National Associations. Mrs. DeLamar was a co-founder and served as President of the Southwest Georgia Genealogical Society. She authored and co-authored many books and periodicals on Genealogy. Mrs. DeLamar also served on the Georgia State Historical Society. She was preceded in death by her husband, Leonard Gibson DeLamar, Sr., and her parents, Henry Prentiss Derry and Minnie Baker Derry.

Mrs. DeLamar is survived by 3 sons: Leonard G. "Lenny" DeLamar, Jr, Albany, Bobby DeLamar, Dawson, Jimmy DeLamar, Albany; 6 grandchildren: Karen
