



Marion Martin Obituary

September 26, 1937 - April 20, 2003

A native of Ft. Gaines, GA, Mr. Martin had lived in Albany since 1955. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Albany, where he had served as a Deacon and Sunday School Teacher. Mr. Martin was honorably discharged from the U.S. Army in March of 1960. He received his BBA degree in accounting from Georgia State University in August 1964. He retired in 2001 from the accounting firm of Martin & Logan, CPA's. He was a Member of the Georgia Society of Certified Public Accountants and the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. He had served as President of the Albany Chapter of the Georgia Society of Certified Public Accountants. He was a member of the Albany Lions Club and was a past President of the club. He was awarded the Melvin Jones Humanitarian Award by Lions International, which is the highest award given by the Lion's Club. He had also served as President of the Dougherty-Lee County Unit of the American Cancer Society.
