



## Martha D. Morrison Obituary

November 26, 1918 - March 31, 2003

She was born on November 26, 1918, in Decatur, GA, the daughter of the late Frank Anderson and Christine Buncke Doughman. She is survived by her husband of 54 years, William R. Morrison, Jr.; her son, W. Ruel Morrison, III of New Orleans, LA; sister, Christine D. Riley of Atlanta, GA and numerous nieces and nephews. Mrs. Morrison graduated from Girls High in Atlanta and was the Honor Graduate of Parsons School of Design in New York City in 1948. She did graduate work at New York University in Art and Design and won the Lady Mendel Scholarship to the Parsons European School in Rome, Paris, and London. In 1942 she joined the Women's Army Corps. She served in the European Theater during WW II and was stationed in London as an aide to General Eister. In 1945 she was transferred to Paris, France and witnessed the liberation of Paris by Allied Forces. Mrs. Morrison moved to Albany in January 1950 and with her husband established Morrison's Interiors on Pine Ave. A talented and accomplished artist and designer, she used her professional expertise in her volunteer activities as well as the business. She was a life member of the Charity League, Thronteeska Heritage Foundation, Albany Art Museum, The Albany Symphony, Theater Albany and St. Paul's Episcopal Church.
