Mary Elizabeth McCorkle Horne 99, of 914 W. Society Ave in Albany died March 17, 2008 at Palmyra Nursing Home. Mrs. Horne was born in 1909 in Buena Vista, Ga. At a very young age, her family moved to South Georgia and bought a farm near Anderson City, south of Sylvester. Here, her siblings were born and she, being the oldest, became known as "Sister". The "Great depression" took its toll on the family farm. They moved and for many years lived near New Elm, north of Moultrie. Elizabeth attended high school in Sylvester and continued to be the big "Sister" to the family. This all changed in 1929 when she married Crawford Eric Horne. Crawford was the youngest son of George Washington Horne of Doerun. After several years on the farm, the family moved to Albany in 1934, with a young son, Billy, in tow. There Crawford pursued his chosen profession of Barber until his death in 1996. She attended First Methodist Church, and was a lifetime member of Beulah Sapp's Sunday school class and a member of the Circle Meetings. In addition to her husband, Elizabeth was preceded in death by her brothers A.J. McCorkle, Paul McCorkle, and her sister Merrill M. Griffin. -Survivors include her children, Jeanene H.
