Mary L. Youngblood of 1739 Arlington Park Circle, passed away on June 13th at Wynfield Park Rehab. She was "87".

Born and raised in Albany, Mary had lived in Hiawassee for 20 plus years. After her beloved husband, Owen Youngblood passed away, she decided to move back to Albany to be near her family.
