Mary Lewis Shemwell, 95, died Tuesday, March 17, 2015 at Evergreen.

Her funeral Mass will be at 11 AM on Saturday, March 21, 2015 at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with burial of her cremated remains to follow at Oakview Cemetery. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Friday from 6-8 PM.

Mrs. Shemwell was born in Atlanta, but lived most of her life in Albany. She attended schools here and graduated from Albany High School in the Class of 1936. She was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church. Mrs. Shemwell was a member of the Charity League of Albany, and a group of her friends gathered together and named themselves the Friday Girls Group. She was preceded in death by her husband, Dermot "Bud" Shemwell; a son, Mot Shemwell; a grandson, Tyler Shemwell.
