



## Melvina Strenth Rogers Obituary

Melvina Strenth Rogers, of Leesburg, died Monday, June 19, 2006 at her residence. The funeral service will be held at 11 AM Friday at Lakeside Baptist Church with interment to follow in Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. Ken Chancellor will officiate. A native of Sylvester, Mrs. Rogers grew up in Worth County and had lived in Lee County since 1960. She retired from Bellsouth after more than thirty years of service. Mrs. Rogers was a member of Lakeside Baptist Church where she was a member of the Fellowship Sunday School Class, the Adult Choir, and a member of the Lakeside Quartet.
