Mervyn was born in Dawson, GA, the son of Ozella Jennings Bridges and Martin Luther Bridges. Mervyn retired from Graybar Electric Company as Branch Manager after 30 years of service and began a career as the owner of Casa Blanca Motel in Daytona Beach Shores, FL. After WWII he worked as Field Supply Manager for the Tennessee Valley Authority during the construction years. During WWII he worked in constructing the United States Naval facilities in Vieques, Puerto Rico.
