Jason "Geiger" Geiger, 32, of Brooklyn, NY, formerly of Albany, died Tuesday, June 20, 2006 in Brooklyn, NY. His funeral service will be held at 11 AM Saturday at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors in Albany, GA with Rev. Finbarr Stanton officiating. The interment service will be held at 3 PM in Quitman, GA at Oak Hill Cemetery with Rev. David Lassiter officiating. A native of Albany, Mr. Geiger graduated from Westover High School in 1992. He graduated from Darton College in 1996 and moved to Atlanta where he attended the Art Institute of Atlanta and received his Culinary Arts degree in 1999. While in Atlanta, he worked at Druid Hills Country Club as a chef. Mr. Geiger was a featured chef on Turner South's Southern Living program. He moved to Brooklyn, NY three and a half years ago where he worked as a chef at various restaurants in New York and was currently a Chef at Hudson Hotel in Manhattan, NY. Mr. Geiger was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church here in Albany, and was a member of several different bands in the area. He was very close to all of his family and friends. He was preceded in death by his paternal grandfather, Cecil Geiger of Quitman, and his maternal grandparents: Boots and Bob Crowley of Tifton. Mr. Geiger is survived by his parents, Jerry and Teresa Geiger of Albany; his sister, Becky Geiger Folk and her husband Dan of Greenville, SC; his paternal grandmother, Ethel Geiger of Quitman; and numerous aunts, uncles, and cousins; and many friends. A prayer service will be held this evening at 7 PM at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors with visitation to follow until 8:30 PM. Those desiring may make
