



Michael Blanchard Obituary

September 21, 1961 - September 1, 2006

Michael Randall "Mike" Blanchard, 44, of Albany, died Friday from injuries suffered in an automobile accident. His funeral service will be TUESDAY 4 PM at Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church. The Rev. Nathan Godley will officiate. Burial services will be in Russellville, KY. A native of Alexandria, La., Mr. Blanchard was born Sept. 21, 1961. He is the son of Randall M. Blanchard, Newberry, FL and Joan H. Catcart, Albany. He graduated from Windsor Forest High School, Savannah, GA in 1980 and attended Young Harris College in Young Harris, GA. After college, he worked in the banking profession before beginning a career in the automotive industry at Savannah Toyota. He worked with Applied Transportation Concepts, Birmingham, AL as an automotive consultant, working with Ford, Chrysler, and the Southeast Toyota dealerships for eight years while residing in Russellville, KY. He came to Albany in 2003 to open the new Fairway Toyota where he served as General Manager. In 2005, he was the recipient of the prestigious President's Award from Toyota Motor Corporation. Earlier this month he was featured in Time magazine recognizing his success with Toyota and his work with the Albany community. He was a member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church, and was a Mason. In addition to his mother and father, he is survived by his wife: Susan (Sue Lynn) Neely Blanchard, Albany; 2 daughters: Neely Blanchard, Bowling Green, KY, Savannah Blanchard, Albany; 2 sisters: Tracie Blanchard Danzey, Atlanta and Heather Cathcart, Augusta; a grandmother: Hattie Clifton, Savannah, GA, father and mother-in-law: Ray and Sally Neely, Russellville,

KY; brother-in-law: Bryan Neely and his wife Samone, Nashville, TN. The family will receive friends at Fairway Toyota on Ledo Rd. on Monday from 2-6 PM. They will also receive friends at Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church on Tuesday from 2 PM until the funeral hour. Those desiring may send memorials to Children's Educational Fund, c/o U. S.
