



Michael A. Rosser, Sr. Obituary

September 5, 1948 - October 28, 2006

Michael A. "Mike" Rosser Sr., 58, of Loganville, formerly of Albany, died Saturday at Emory Eastside Medical Center in Snellville. His funeral service will be 2 PM Wednesday at Kimbrell-Stern Funerals with interment to follow in Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. Bobby Harrell will officiate. The family will receive friends 6 PM to 8 PM, Tuesday, October 31, 2006, at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors. A native of Americus, Mr. Rosser had lived in Loganville for the past 5 years. He served his country as a member of the United States Army from 1967 to 1969 and as a reservist until 1972. He was a graduate of Georgia Southwestern College and a graduate of Louisiana State University Graduate School of Banking. He was employed by the Georgia Department of Banking and Finance for approximately 30 years, beginning his career as an assistant bank examiner in the Albany, Georgia office. He rose through the examiner ranks quickly and in 2002 after serving as a Senior Financial Examiner for 19 years, Mike was promoted to the Supervisory Examiner management level in the metro Atlanta area. Mike specialized in the examinations of holding companies, international banks and troubled financial institutions. He was well known for his ability to deal effectively with bank managements and his ability to work with institutions to resolve supervisory and regulatory concerns. He achieved the designation of Certified Examinations Manager with the Conference of State Bank Supervisors. He also achieved the Certified Financial Examiner designation with the Society of Financial Examiners, participating in many national conventions. He was preceded in death by his

parents, Hugh and Epsie Ann Stripling Rosser and a brother Gary RosserHe is survived by his son Michael A. Rosser Jr. of Douglasville; his daughter Leigh Ann Rosser Owens of Leesburg and his granddaughter Mary Daylen Hormilla his sister Doris Rosser Littlejohn (Wayne) of Winterhaven FL and brother Dick M. Rosser(Patricia) of Lawrenceville.
