A native of Atlanta, he was the son of the late Henry Wood Usry and Virginia Elizabeth Usry. Mr. Usry was raised in Albany and graduated from St. Teresa's Catholic School. He was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church. After graduation, Mr. Usry received his undergraduate degree from The University of the South, known by many as "Sewanee". He received his doctorate in jurisprudence from the University of Georgia in 1979. Mr. Usry became a member of the State Bar of Georgia in 1979. After graduation, he began working as an English professor at UGA. Mr. Usry lived most of his life in Atlanta where he worked with Hines Law firm. He was an avid reader, loved travel, art, food and drink. Michael was a good friend to many people. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by two sisters, Pamela Usry Franklin and Susan Lumpkin; and a brother, John Robert Usry.

Mr. Usry is survived by three nephews, Stuart Franklin, Jack Franklin, Michael Pauquette, and three nieces, Kim Duren, Elizabeth Marquardt, and Pamela Cain.
