



## Mrs. Mildred Goldsmith Faber

December 8, 1916 - December 4, 2018

Mrs. Mildred Faber, 101, of Albany, GA., died on December 4, 2018 with her family at her side.

The funeral service will be Friday at 2:00 PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

Mildred was the devoted daughter of Martin Goldsmith originally from Brest-Litovsk, Russia and Celia Millenky Goldsmith originally from Babruysk, Russia, both of whom immigrated to the United States to escape persecution and poverty.

Mildred was born at home in Albany in December 1916. She Graduated from Albany High School in 1933 and married Eduard J. Faber, Sr. in 1942. They left Albany that year due to Mr. Faber's service in World War II. They returned to Albany in 1946 and spent the rest of their lives in Albany and Edison, GA.

Mildred was fiercely dedicated to her family and yet balanced it with a desire to have a career, and thus worked most of her adult life. Her last position was in administration at Edison Textiles, Inc., a well-respected and successful manufacturer of children's clothing which her husband lead and co-founded.

Mildred was known for her independence, strong character and great sense of humor. She was continually active throughout her life, with many different interests from gardening, to politics, to exercising.

She is predeceased by her husband, Eduard, who died in 1995 and her two brothers, Dr. Abe Goldsmith, a highly dedicated OBGYN in Albany, and Walter Goldsmith, a well-known retail merchant in Albany. Survivors include her sons, Eduard J. Faber Jr. (Mary) of Albany and David Faber (Dorothy Serdenis) of

New York City, two granddaughters, Susan Faber Lobdell (Mike) of Atlanta and Julie Faber-Miller (Chris) of Tifton, and two great-grandchildren, Gabriel and Claire Lobdell.
