



Milton Baldrige Merts Obituary

Milton Baldrige Merts, Jr. of Albany died Saturday May 26, 2007 at his residence. The remains have been cremated and a private memorial service will be held at a later date. A native of Atlanta, GA, Mr. Merts was a 1942 graduate of Georgia Tech University and was founder and president of Merts Manufacturing and Engineering Company. Mr. Merts was a naval officer during WWII aboard the USS Quincy. He was a 57 year member of the Albany Lions Club. He was a member of the Golden Key Club and a long time member of the Albany YMCA. Mr. Merts was also a member of Little Cumberland Island Association and a member of H2U at Palmyra Park Medical Center. Survivors include his wife Romona B. Merts of Albany, children, Milton Merts III, of Summitt, NJ, Peter Merts of San Rafael, CA, Elizabeth Albritton and her husband Robert of San Rafael, CA, grandchildren, Caitlin Albritton and Nicholas Albritton. 2 stepchildren, Karyl Sumner and her husband Phillip of Leesburg and Karen McCann and her husband John of Crawfordville, FL.
