



Milton C. Sterling, Sr. Obituary

August 29, 1924 - August 8, 2004

A native of Crisfield, Maryland, he had lived in Titusville since 1994, moving from Albany. Mr. Sterling served in the US Marine Corps during World War II. He graduated from George Washington University with a B.A. degree in accounting. He became a Certified Public Accountant in 1958, and retired as a Partner with Mauldin & Jenkins, CPAs in Albany, GA in 1989. Mr. Sterling was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church where he served on the Parish Council and was Chairman of the Finance Committee. He was a 4th Degree Knight and Past Grand Knight of the Knights of Columbus. Mr. Sterling was Past President of the United Way of Southwest Georgia, the Southwest Council of the Boy Scouts of America (awarded the Silver Beaver in 1974), the Albany Chapter of the Georgia Society of CPAs, the Albany Estate Planning Council, and the Albany Toastmasters International. Mr. Sterling served on the Executive Committee of the Walter H. Burt American Legion Post 30, and was a member of the Golden K Kiwanis Club. He served on the Tripartite Committee for the Indigent Defense Office, and was awarded the Dougherty County Bar Associations Liberty Bell Award.
