Nancy Toomey Cartmell 60, of Albany, died Sunday at Palmyra Medical Center. The public is invited to attend her funeral service at 10 AM Friday, July 27, 2007 at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, located at the corner of Partridge and Westgate Blvd. with interment to follow in Riverside City Cemetery, Edward Draper will dedicate the grave. Bishop Phil Millerd will officiate, with Ritchey Marbury assisting. Nancy, a native of Easton MD had lived in Albany for the past 34 years. She was an active member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, serving as Sunday School teacher and in the Relief Society. She was the greatest mother, grandmother, sister and most caring citizen of all. She was employed by Marbury Engineering as a bookkeeper for more than 9 years and was Engineering Associate for the City of Albany for the past 18 years. She was a past president of the Citizens Advisory Committee, served on the Albany Tree Board, and was an instructor for Customer Service Classes for the City of Albany employees. Cartmell Avenue was named in her honor. She held a 4th degree Black Belt in karate and Nancy was a staff member of the YMCA of Albany as a karate instructor and was and judged at numerous karate tournaments. The loves of her life were her children, grandchildren, Georgia Bulldogs and NASCAR's #24, Jeff Gordon. GO DAWGS!
