Middleton Nathaniel (Nat) Ridley, Jr., 78, died Saturday March 25, 2006 at Palmyra Nursing Home after a long battle with Parkinson Disease. Funeral service will be held on Tuesday 2:00 PM at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow in Crown Hill Cemetery with military honors. Dr. William E. (Butch) Knight, Jr. and Rev. Tom W. Davis officiating. A native of Appling County, Mr. Ridley was a veteran of the United States Army and served during the Korean Conflict.
