Kimbrell-Stern Obituary - Nov. 26, 2004 Oscar Forney Loosier, Jr. "Spec", of 622 Russell Rd. died Wednesday, November 24, 2004. The funeral service will be held Saturday, 3 PM at the First Baptist Church with interment in Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. Perry Webb and Rev. Dan Robinson will officiate. Mr. Loosier was born in Decatur, Alabama on March 7, 1925 to Oscar Forney Loosier and Cora Lee Little. He attended North Georgia College and served in the Naval Air Corp during World War II. Spec moved to Albany in 1946 and opened Loosier of Albany Furniture Company which he owned until 1985. He married Sara Elizabeth New of Thomaston, GA on November 15, 1947. He was a member of the of the Albany Exchange Club, served as president of the Georgia Home Furnishings Association and was at one time a member of the Central Albany Development Authority. Spec was a member of First Baptist Church for 56 years where he served as a deacon, taught Sunday School for many years and served as chairman of the finance committee. He was preceded in death by two grandsons, Oscar Loosier and Thomas Loosier. Spec is survived by his wife, Elizabeth New Loosier, five children, Mike Loosier and his wife, Abbi Hamilton Loosier of Albany, Lee Eady and her husband Chuck of Birmingham, AL, Eddie Loosier and his wife Sue Jenkins Loosier of Gainesville, GA, Grant Loosier and his wife Pat Harrell Loosier of Macon, Lynn Loosier of New York City, two sisters, Elizabeth L.
